1. THE APARTMENT: YOUR HOME BY THE SEA

Layout & Features:

- **Open-Plan Living:** The main space combines the living area, dining area, and a fully-equipped kitchen.
- **Bedrooms:** Two spacious bedrooms (all en-suite) with mosquito nets, ample storage, and ceiling fans. The master bedroom opens onto the balcony.
- **The Balcony/Veranda:** Your outdoor living room! Featuring comfortable seating and the unbeatable vista of the Indian Ocean. Perfect for sunrise coffees and sundowners.
- **Kitchen:** Equipped with a fridge-freezer, gas cooker & oven, microwave, kettle, toaster, and all necessary cookware, crockery, utensils and water dispenser in the living room, if you ran out of drinking water or gas, please call the caretaker (**Mr. Tunje 0723932210**).

How to Use Key Amenities:

- **Air Conditioning & Fans:** Please use the A/C responsibly. We recommend using the ceiling fans where possible and only cooling the rooms when you're in them. Turn off A/C when you go out.
- **Gas Cooker:** Instructions are on the kitchen wall. Always ensure the gas cylinder valve is turned off at the source after cooking.
- **Hot Water:** The solar geyser provides hot water. On cloudy days, give it time to heat or use the electric backup switch (labeled in the utility area) for a short boost.



2. House Rules & Essentials

Check-in/out:

Check-in: From 10:00 AM. Early arrival? Please contact us, and we'll accommodate if possible.

Check-out: By 10:00 AM. A late check-out may be possible upon prior request.

Sustainability & Comfort:

Water: Kilifi is in a semi-arid region. Please use water sparingly.

Power: We are on solar power where possible. Please switch off lights, fans, and A/C when not in use. Be mindful of energy consumption.

Waste: Please use the labeled bins (general waste & recyclables).

Community & Respect:

Noise: This is a quiet residential area. Please keep noise to a minimum between 8:00 PM and 8:00 AM.

Security: Always lock the apartment door and balcony doors when you go out. The compound is guarded, but vigilance is key.

No smoking inside the house. You may smoke on the balcony; please use the ashtrays provided.

Pets: Not allowed, sorry.

3. Getting Connected

- **Wi-Fi:** Network: CB3_101 5G | Password: [will be provided on arrival]
 - **Note:** Speeds can be variable. It's perfect for browsing and messages, but streaming may be slower.
- **Electricity:** Plugs are UK-style (Type G). Adapters are provided in the kitchen drawer.
- **Local SIM:** We recommend getting a local Safaricom or Airtel SIM for better mobile data. Kiosks are in town.

4. Exploring Kilifi: Our Top Picks

Food & Drink:

For a Treat: Distinct Destinations (Monsoons) – stunning sunset views, great cocktails, and food.

Moorings and La Marina on Mtwapa Creek – delicious Swahili cuisine right over the water.

Vipingo Shopping Centre – 20 mins away on the main Mombasa – Malindi road and The Boatyard at Kilifi Creek.

Coffee & Breakfast: Fadhili Cafe – the best coffee in town and hearty breakfasts.

Home Cooking: The local market in town has fantastic fresh produce. Don't miss the mangoes!

Things to Do:

On the Water: Go kayaking or paddleboarding on the creek. You can arrange this through **Kilifi Boatyard** or **Kiwani Spa**.

Culture & History: Visit the **Mnarani Ruins** (ancient Swahili settlement) – it's a short walk away!

Day Trip: Take a boat to **Mnemba Island** (seasonal) or explore the **Kuruwitu Conservancy** for snorkeling.

Relaxation: Book a massage at **Kiwani Spa** or simply walk along **Bofa Beach** at low tide.

Practical Shopping:

Quickmart supermarket – At Mtwapa shopping centre

Small store near the house – Its called Sultan Souk and open daily from 8am to 9 pm.

- **ATM:** Several Equity, KCB, and ABSA ATMs are available in the town center.
- **Pharmacy:** **Goodlife** or **Mega** pharmacy are reliable.

- **Nearest Police Station:** Kijipwa Police station 20 minutes away

Getting Around:

- **Tuk-tuks:** The standard way to get around town. Agree on a price (KES 100–300 around town) before you set off.
- **Boda-Bodas (Motorbikes):** Fast and cheap for single riders. Always wear a helmet.
- **Car Hire:** Can be arranged for longer trips. Ask us for contacts.

Health: Tap water is not for drinking. Use the provided bottled water or the water dispenser. Use mosquito repellent, especially at dusk and dawn.
